- Pre-qualified experiences have been reviewed by the Kimmel Belonging and Engagement Hub and meet the community service specifications.
- Excluded experiences do NOT meet the community service expectations and will NOT receive final approval.

Scholarship recipients are responsible for ascertaining whether or not an experience qualifies as community service for the JH Scholarship. Final approval decisions will not be made on the basis of a recipient's lack of awareness or misunderstanding of qualification and exclusion specifications and/or failure to adequately research experiences prior to committing to and/or participating in the experience.
