Notes for Consideration:

- This rubric emphasizes **independence** and **originality**, ensuring that students demonstrate personal engagement with the assignment and rely solely on their own ideas, critical thinking, and writing skills.
- Evidence of independent work is critical, as it directly addresses the requirement that generative AI must not be used. This can be assessed through personal reflections, detailed outlines, drafts, and the quality of final work that shows genuine effort.
- Clear guidelines on plagiarism and AI use should be communicated to students beforehand, so they understand the expectations and how their work will be evaluated.

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
