

Senior With Degree Taking Undergraduate Prerequisite Classes for Admission to a Second Undergraduate Program

Instructions:

- Read these instructions thoroughly and complete Section 1.
- Contact your program advisor to complete Section 2.

Complete Section 2 with your program advisor, based on the following criteria:

You will need to meet with your advisor to determine which courses are still needed for admission into your program, and when you will take them. An approval of this GUNCLB request will allow you to receive federal aid for a maximum of **THREE CONSECUTIVE SEMESTERS** (one calendar year). Each course, along with the corresponding term of enrollment, should be listed on the attached form. All listed classes **MUST** be undergraduate prerequisites required for admission to your anticipated bachelor's program. The academic plan (prerequisite class schedule) needs to be signed by your program advisor or director.

- **Eligibility criteria for approval:** Per federal regulations, a student seeking financial assistance from federal Title IV programs must normally be on record with the University as degree seeking. However, an exception may be made for a student in Senior with Degree status if they are taking UNDERGRADUATE courses as PREREQUISITES for acceptance into a **second undergraduate program**. A minimum of **six credit hours** of prerequisites is required for each term to qualify for loans. All enrolled hours **MUST** be required for admission to your program. By submitting the attached form, you may request approval to borrow Federal Stafford Student Loan funds at the following annual levels:

**Dependent student - \$7,500 subsidized/unsubsidized (maximum \$5,500 sub),
Lifetime dependent loan maximum of \$31,000 total.**

**Independent student - \$12,500 subsidized/unsubsidized (maximum \$5,500 sub),
Lifetime independent loan maximum of \$57,500 total.**

- **Ineligible Categories:** Approval will not be granted to a student who was denied admission to a graduate program due to a late graduate admission application, low grade point average, or low qualifying test scores.
- **Students in "Unclassified Graduate" status are not eligible for federal financial aid.**
