- **Assignments Sent:** Week of December 9 to your SIUE email.
- **Charges Posted:** Housing charges added to your SIUE account week of December 9.
- **Move-In Start Date:** January 11 at 12:00 PM (noon).

**Move-In Instructions:** Included in your housing assignment email.

**Connect with Your Roommate and Suitemates:** Reach out and introduce yourselves.

# WHAT TO BRING

- **Bedding:** Twin or Full XL sheets and blankets.
- **Refrigerator:** 5.0 cubic feet or less (rental program available).
- **Computer:** Wireless internet and data jacks are provided.
- **Ethernet Cord:** For reliable, high-speed connection.
- **Cleaning Supplies:** Residents are responsible for cleaning their room and bathroom.
- **Personal Touches:** Photos and décor to make your space feel like home.

# WHAT *NOT* TO BRING

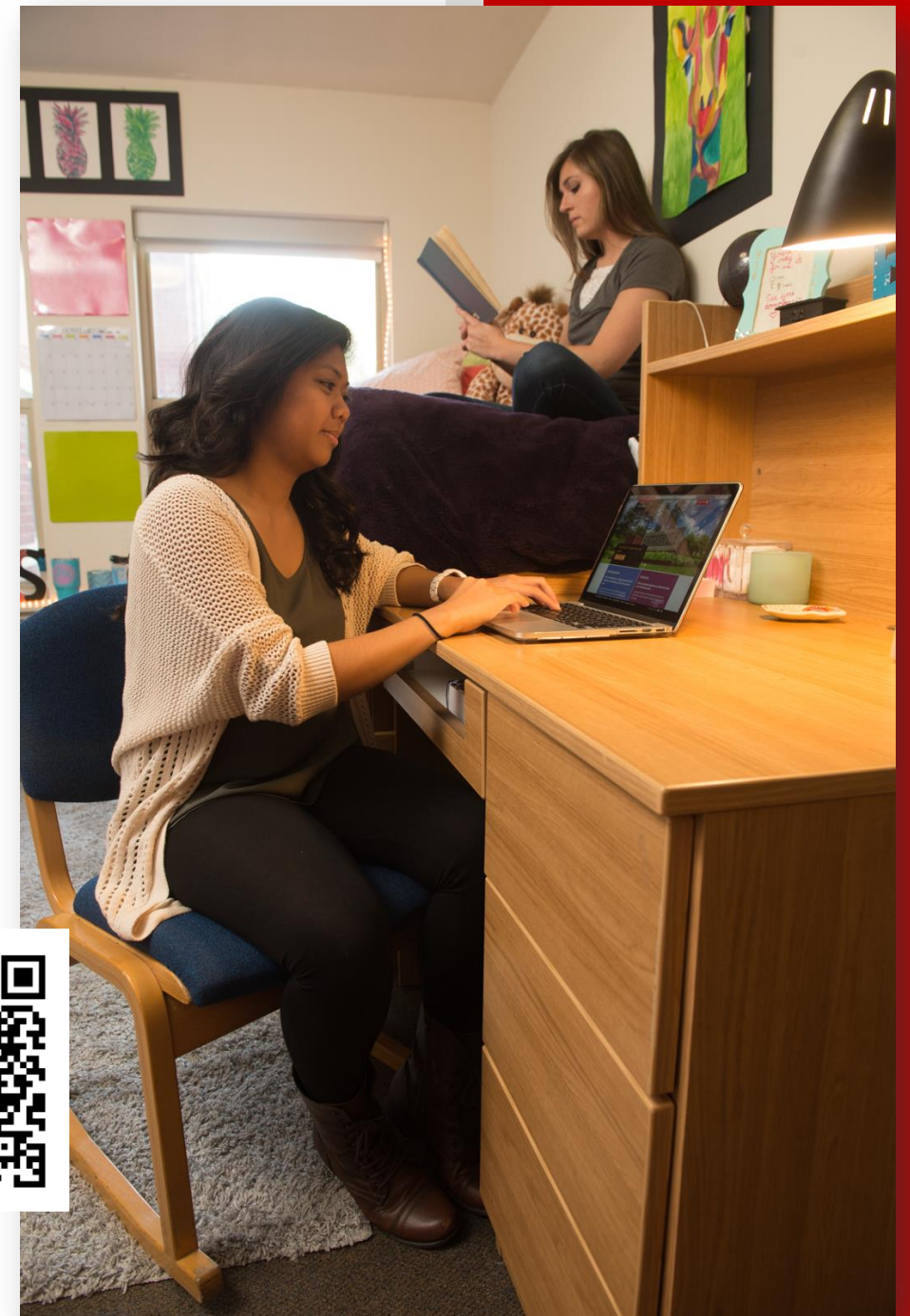
- ✗ **Pets:** Only aquarium fish are allowed.
- ✗ **Alcohol Containers:** Both empty and full are not permitted.
- ✗ **Cooking Appliances:** No appliances with open heating elements.
- ✗ **LED Lights:** Adhesive strip lighting is not allowed.
- ✗ **Liquid Bleach:** Not permitted in residence halls.
- ✗ **Wireless Printers:** Our network requires a cable connection.

# MAINTENANCE REQUESTS

- **Fast and Reliable Service:**
  - 94% of maintenance requests completed within **3 business days**.
  - 91% completed within **48 hours** of submission.
- **Submitting a Request is Easy:**
  - Connect to campus WiFi and submit your request online.
- **Common Requests Include:**
  - Raise, lower, or bunk your bed.
  - Fix a leaking sink.
  - Change a light bulb.
- For quick solutions, let University Housing Facilities Management (UHFM) handle it!
