Pathway - Speech Pathology and Audiology**

Careers with a BS degree: speech aid, speech assistant, speech implementer, medical sales, medical publications, rehabilitation administration.

*A course that satisfies both the ERGU and EREG requirement will only be counted as one and not both.

Students must obtain a Master's Degree in an accredited program to become a Speech Pathologist and a Doctor of Audiology degree to become an Audiologist.

Admission requirements to the Speech Pathology and Audiology program:

1. Cumulative 2.75 GPA
2. SPPA 101 (B or higher)
