### Brief description of the nature of the research/creative activity?

This project investigates the cultural landscape of botanical gardens in the United States. A

database has been created that details the characteristics (such as location, founding date, size, and types of display gardens). A sample of gardens from the database will then be selected to study their features, spatial organization, and regional identity. A map will be created to display garden characteristics. The objective is to understand the commonalities that botanical gardens share and the features that represent a garden's unique location.

### Brief description of student responsibilities?

Student responsibilities include maintaining / updating the database of botanical gardens, working with me to identify the study gardens, and assisting with the analysis of documents (e.g., maps, photographs, brochures, and other related documents) to evaluate the cultural landscape of the selected gardens. Additionally, the student may work on creating a map displaying garden features if they have the skill set to do so (map making is not a requirement for the position).
