Reasonable Suspicion Drug and Alcohol Indicators

Below are potential observed indicators that an individual might be under the influence of drugs or alcohol. This is not a comprehensive list since the effect of drugs or alcohol may be different for different people. In addition, some individuals may exhibit these symptoms and may be under the influence of legally prescribed drugs.
